Freedom Schools, created by the Children's Defense Fund, provide summer enrichment in a nurturing environment that helps children gain confidence and enthusiasm for learning. We will work with a director, seven interns from Duke Divinity School, St. Martin's Episcopal Church and Gethsemane UMC to offer this exciting opportunity to 50 children in our community.

Every Monday through Thursday, students will have classroom instruction from 9:00 until 11:45 am. Educational programs and field trips will be held in the afternoons as well as each Friday.
