We praise God for Megan Farr and her family as they head up the work of the Sharing Room! Following worship on **Sunday, June 23**, please join us in the Parlor for our Sharing Room Open House.

You can participate in this ministry by offering donations to the Sharing Room: Kitchen items (cookware, silverware, pots/pans, plates, dishes, cups/glasses, coffee/teapots, etc.); Linens (bedding, blankets, pillows, towels, washcloths, kitchen cloths, potholders, rags); Cleaning supplies (personal: soap, lotion, shampoo, toothpaste/brush; household: dish soap, sponges, laundry detergent, cleaning supplies); Other household items and umbrellas; and Books (Bibles, children's stories, picture books, fiction/nonfiction).

Drop off donations at the church office on Sunday mornings, or Mondays–Thursdays, 8:30 am–4:30 pm.

Prime Timers will meet on Monday, June 24, in the Parlor at 9:30 am for games and fellowship followed by a general meeting at 10:15 am. A potluck lunch of salads and desserts for the summer will be served at 10:30 am. At noon, Theresa Johnson will present a program, "Where Did I Put My Keys." Come learn what is normal forgetfulness and how the brain stores information.

On June 3, upon the recommendation of the Trustees, the Church Council voted unanimously to sell the parsonage on Dumfries. Several realtors have been consulted to walk through and price the house. Once minor repairs have been completed, the parsonage will go on the market.

Our partner health clinic, Casa El Buen Samaritano, is hosting a back-to-school event on Saturday, July 20, from 8–11 am. A new pair of shoes and school supplies will be distributed to about 75 kids. They are looking for a group of 15–20 volunteers who will be able to help run the event. There are work stations to distribute items and greet the families. Most jobs do not require Spanish language skills. It really is a fun event that the kids love, and it is something that a Sunday school class or small group can do as a team. Volunteers should meet in the fellowship hall of the church right next to the clinic at 14060 Dublin Street at 7 am for a brief orientation.
