Chair of Church Council:**

For those who weren't able to attend last Monday's Church Council meeting, I want to give a quick update on the outcome: 1) The Council approved preparations for a churchwide capital campaign; and 2) The Council approved a short-term loan (up to \$100,000), which would cover some immediate repairs needed, any overruns and any professional services needed to prepare for the capital campaign. I praise God for each of you and for the work He is doing through us at Westbury! Stay tuned and be in prayer as to how you might contribute your gifts, talents, service and witness to God's future for this church.

On Sunday, November 18, at 4:00 pm, Willow Meadows Baptist Church will host the annual Braes Interfaith Ministries Service of Thanksgiving.
